



Ford Manufacturer Warranty is **7 years or 100,000kms**

It is made up of **2 years of Base Warranty** (where all warrantied items are covered) + **5 Years of Extended Warranty** where some reasonable exclusions apply because of the effects of Wear & Tear

The warranty includes:

- ✓ Engine
- ✓ Transmission
- ✓ Catalytic converter
- ✓ Front & Rear Axels
- ✓ Steering
- ✓ Braking System (but not friction items)
- ✓ Air Conditiong
- ✓ Heating System
- ✓ Audio System
- ✓ Airbags
- ✓ Electrical System (Engine control, Central Locking, ABS Brakes, Electrically Operated Seats, Electrically Controlled Safety & Convenience features)





Items that are **Excluded** from the 5 Year Extended Warranty are as follows:

- ✘ Body Panels – See L1 Paint surface and perforation warranty.
- ✘ Paint repairs – See L1 Paint surface and perforation warranty.
- ✘ Glass – heater elements are covered
- ✘ Seats – electrical heater elements and mechanical adaption parts are covered
- ✘ Trim, interior and exterior
- ✘ Exhaust systems - (catalytic converters and coated DPF (diesel particulate filter) are covered)
- ✘ Shock absorbers and MacPherson struts
- ✘ Ancillary drive belts
- ✘ Batteries
- ✘ Bulbs
- ✘ Fuses
- ✘ Lamp units
- ✘ Water or air ingress



In order to maintain your Ford Warranty, all Parts and Fluids used during the Warranty period must be **'Genuine Ford Parts'**.

The Service provider must also carry out all Service/Routine Maintenance works **per Ford's Guidelines** and a deviation from these guidelines may void the warranty cover.
